The Steering Committee prioritized the following goals from 1 to 8, according to the survey results and the importance they were given by those who completed the surveys. After much discussion, a plan was developed – as described below. We hope for increased parishioner commitment, according to interests and skills; only with more help can we accomplish all that is desired. An annual evaluation is foreseen in order to review the progress.
