Rectory Vote Follow-Up:

- At its March 30th meeting, the Parish Finance Council accepted the St-Pierre Manor Board's offer to purchase the rectory property.
- The services of lawyer Jack Fleming of Taylor McCaffrey LLP (recommended by the diocese) had been retained to review and help finalize the sale agreement.
- Here are the main points regarding the sale:
 - Sale price is \$350,000, payable upon transfer of the land title.
 - The Parish can continue to occupy the rectory until such time as the Manor indicates the need to vacate the building to allow demolition (six months notice). The Parish will be responsible for the normal operating costs of the rectory during its use.
 - The sale will be officially closed when certain conditions are met, such as the final approval of the subdivision. With the assistance of the Village of St-Pierre-Jolys, things are progressing well.
