Opportunity:

- The St-Pierre Manor would like to expand onto the rectory property and offer new opportunities to the community. A two-story addition is envisaged with 24 two bedroom independent-living units and 18 supportive-living suites.
- This interest prompted the Parish to circulate a survey in the community to better understand its future needs. Responses showed a need to help people in their daily lives (outreach), provide faith enrichment classes (formation) and encourage get-togethers and fundraisers (community). Survey summary included.
- The evaluation of our current infrastructure (presbytery and church) is underway to determine what changes are needed to best meet our needs going forward.
