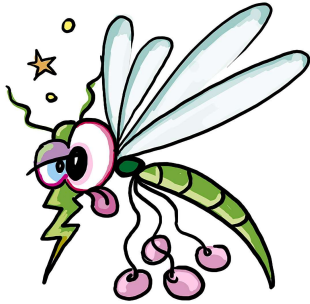

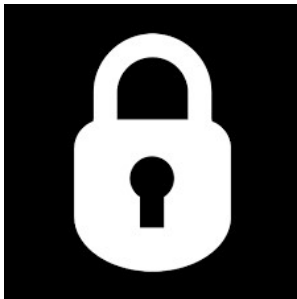
Mosquito tips and tricks

- Mow your lawn
- Prevent the formation of puddles (taps, gutters, sewers).
- Cover your trash cans.
- Prune shrubs and trees to reduce hiding places.
- Avoid leaving piles of grass, leaves or wood.

If necessary, there are many options for treating your personal properties against mosquitoes.
