2020 Tax Payment Deadline

The deadline for payment of your 2020 property taxes is <u>October 31st</u>. However, the 31st is a Saturday, so please try and have your payment made before the 30th. A

penalty charge of 1.25% will be added as of November 1st. And consecutively every month following. So be sure to have your payment in before October 31st. If paying through telpay, please allow 2 to 3 days for the payment to be processed. If the payment is sent on October 31st, we may not receive it until November 2nd or 3rd.

For members of a Credit Union, you may pay through Telpay by adding the Village of St-Pierre-Jolys as a payee and using your roll number as the account number. We are also accepting E-Transfer sent to info@villagestpierrejolys.ca. For E-Transfer, please send in a separate email the answer to the security question as well as the amount paid and address of property. You may also send a cheque in the mail to Box 218, St-Pierre-Jolys, MB R0A 1V0

If you must come to the office, here are the guidelines:

• Only one person in the building at once. Please wait until staff has sanitized before entering.

- Wearing a mask is strongly recommended.
- If you or someone close to you are feeling ill, please do not enter the office.
- Please stay behind the plexiglass at the counter.
