I would like to finish by wishing you all a healthy, safe, and prosperous new year!

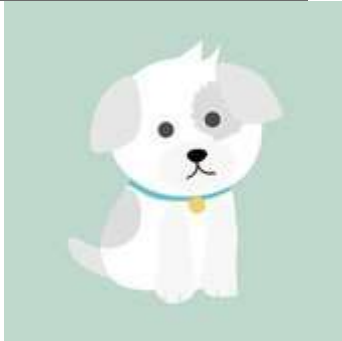
