#### Message from the Mayor:



#### Hello,

Well, it's been an interesting Month of April. Do you know what to wear when you go outside? One day you could be in shorts and the next you're wearing at least a sweater or jacket and shoveling snow. Here's hoping the Month of May is going to be a better one than April.

So what's going on in St-Pierre-Jolys? Well let me tell you that there are a few things happening this month. We've hired a new Operations Manager so keep your eye on our website and Facebook page to see who will be part of our team. On May 6 those interested in becoming a councillor will be able to pick up their documentation to get the ball rolling.

Depending on the weather and COVID restrictions you should be seeing the splash pad getting open by the long weekend in May. Valley Fibre will continue the installation of the Fibre Optic lines throughout the summer with the end being about August and when it comes to construction, I am sure that will depend on the weather also.

You should be seeing the new toboggan hill being Hydro seeded and when you do please do not go on the hill until there is a good layer of grass so as to not disturb the germination process. The less we disturb it the nicer the grass will look. At some point, not sure if it will be this month but the Parc Carillon committee will be erecting another shelter like the other two close to the Splash pad and play structures.

Things to keep in mind during the spring and summer:

- As mentioned in an earlier report, make sure you empty water from any containers, tires or whatever holds water to mitigate the mosquito population.
- Keep your yard clean and grass cut. We often have people visiting the village while out for a drive. Showing them the pride that we have just might encourage some of them to settle in our great community.

- If you are thinking of starting a summer project, like building a deck or shed or adding a fence, make sure you call the Village office first for information on what might be required.
- Be careful when driving by our public works staff and summer students. They are operating noisy machines and may not hear you coming.
- If you see some vandalism happening, please call the RCMP. They may not come right away but the more we report vandalism the more they will make an effort. The RCMP has advised the Village that if no one calls, they will not know what's happening around town.
